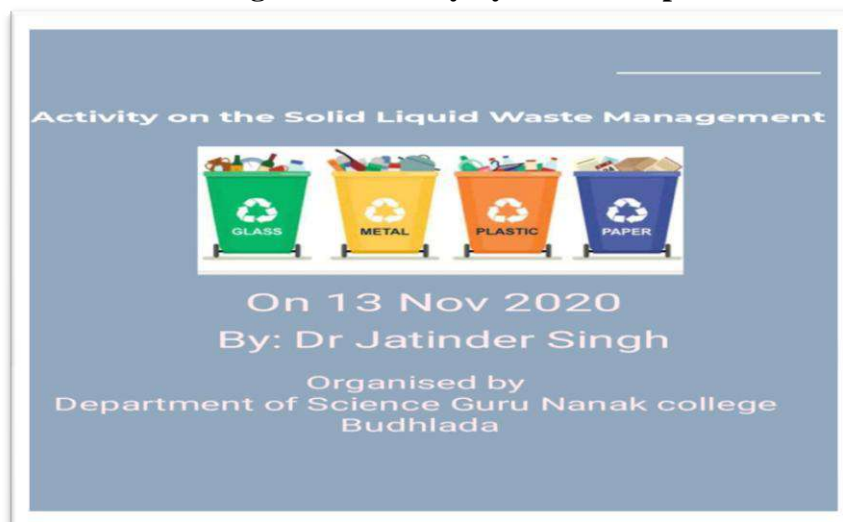

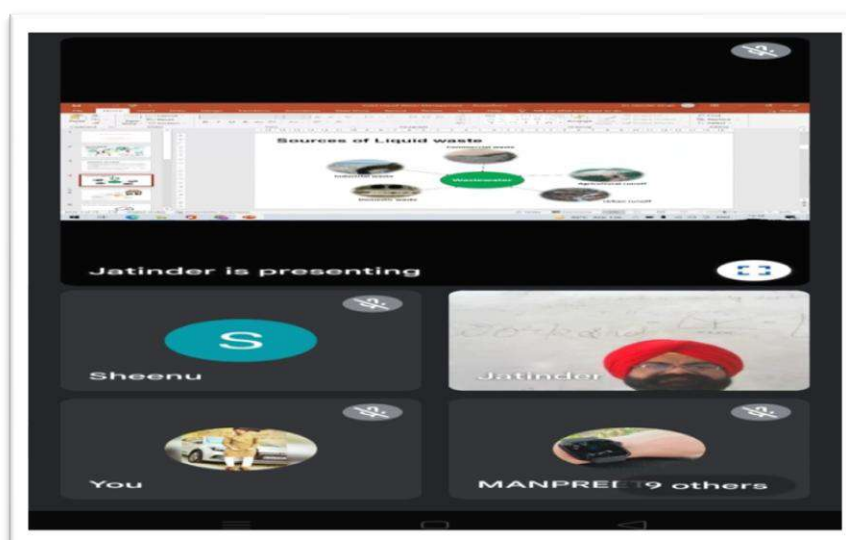
## Session 2020-2021

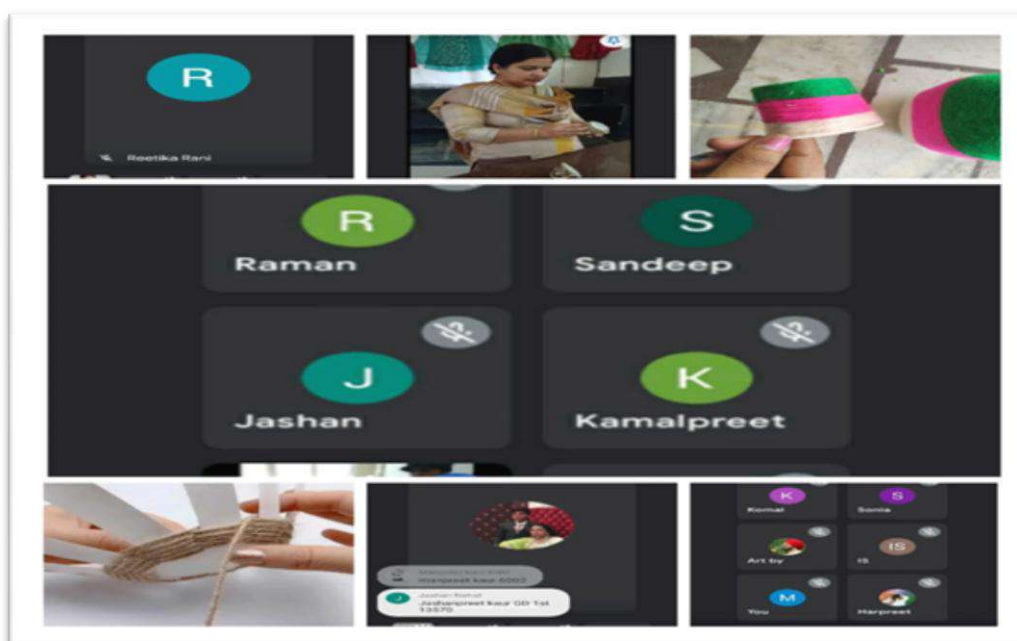
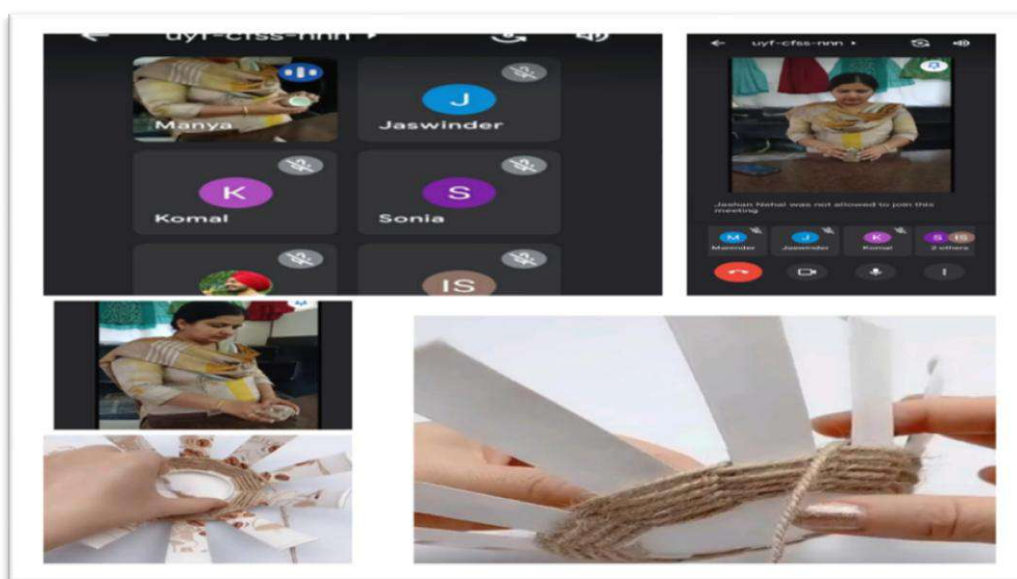
## Workshop on Solid Waste Management by Home Science

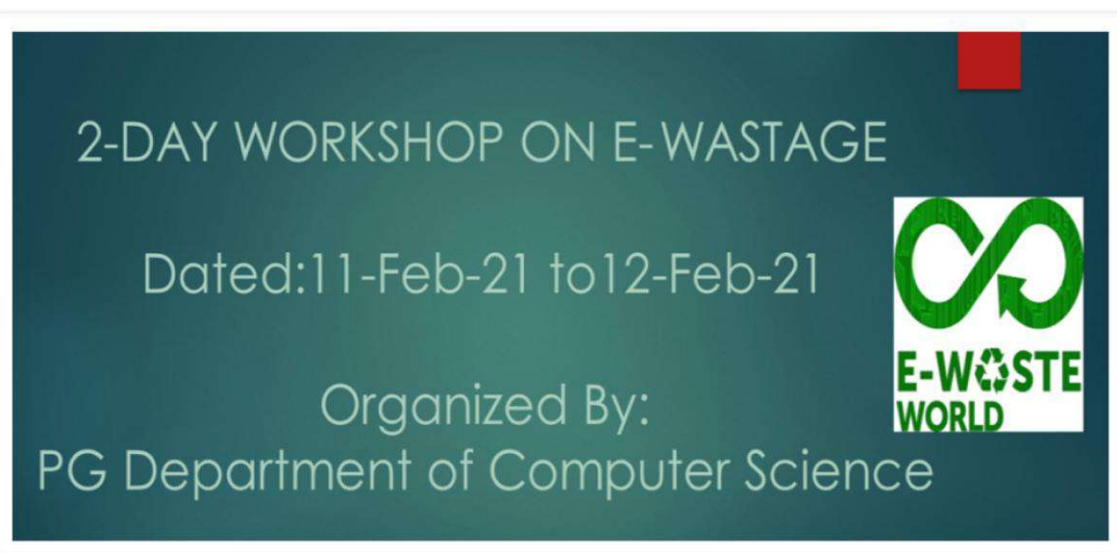
