The overall objective of this scheme is educational and services to community. It is student centred program in which projects are implemented by NSS volunteers.

NSS department organizes various 1-day & 7-days camps every year in which cleanness drives, blood donation camps, various awareness lectures and rallies on social evils are conducted.




Figure 17: Name of leaders at college level of Whats Up Buddy system.
