It was followed by IQAC Coordinator Dr. Narinder Singh, who encouraged and motivated the faculty to explore all possible ways to enhance the teaching experience of both faculty and students.

A presentation on the current teaching scenario at Guru Nanak College was delivered by Mr. Narinder Singh, where they shared the details and outcomes of the survey conducted on the teaching session.

The second day commenced with the presentation of Ms. Rekha Rani, Assistant Professor of Computer Science. 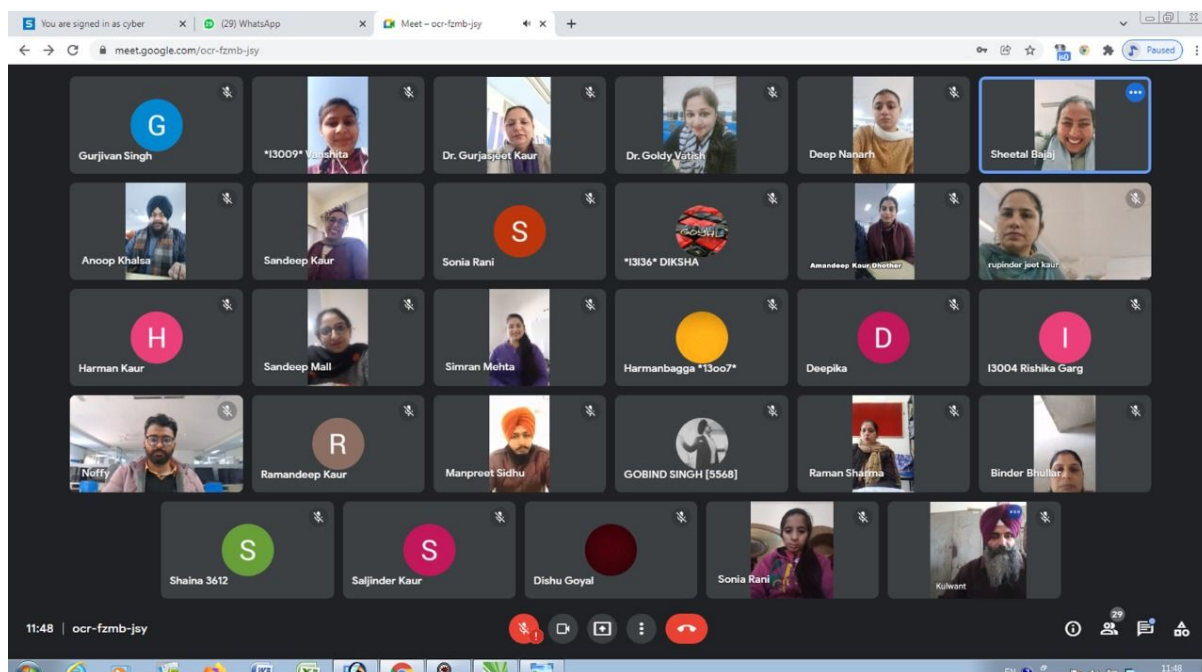




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DAY 1

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

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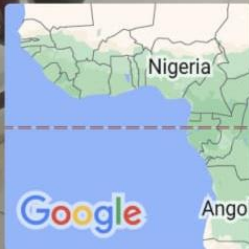
